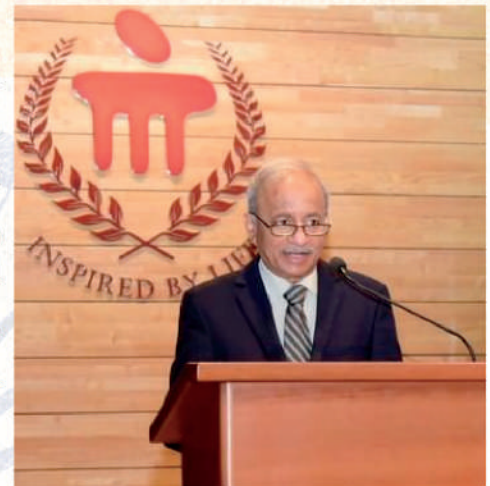
Inaugural Function

On 4th August 2022, the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MSJoE) conducted an online National Youth & Students Interaction Program "Nashe Se Azadi" organized as part of our Nation's 75 years of Independence celebration, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, chaired by Dr. Virendra Kumar (Hon. Union Minister, MoSJE) and moderated by Mrs. Radhika Chakravarthy (Joint Secretary, MoSJE), along with the representatives, faculty and students of 75 selected institutions.

Prior to joining the Ministry's program, MAHE conducted an Inaugural program to mark the start of its Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebration. The function began with a prayer dance by Ms. Sandhya (BBA 3rd year student, Department of Commerce, MAHE) who performed Kuchipudi invocation dance, Ganapati Vandana. 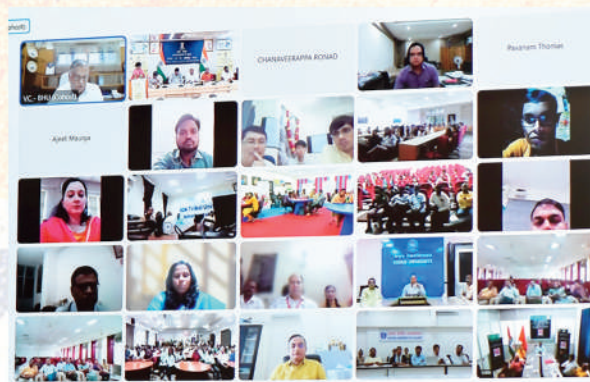

MCODS Manipal was India's first private dental college established in 1965, offering Bachelors and Masters degree courses in dentistry.

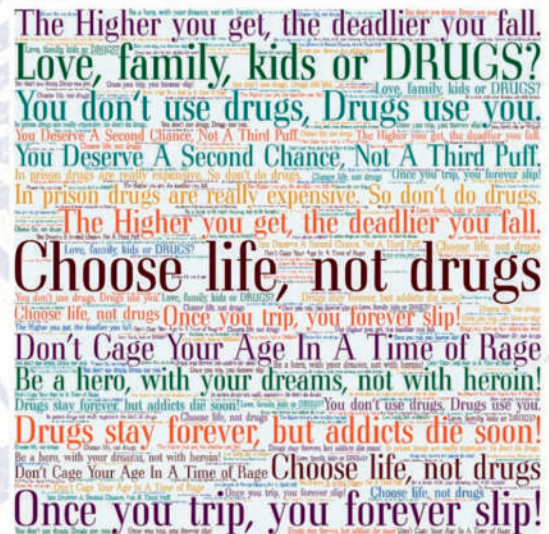

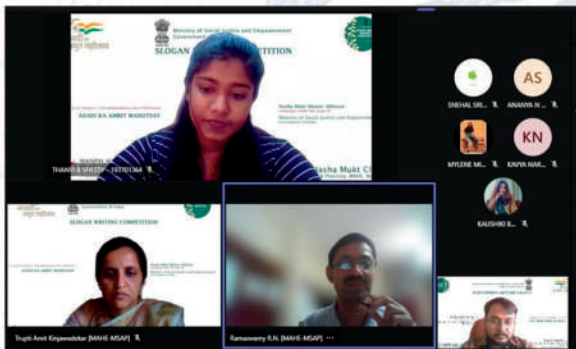
Manipal School of Architecture & Planning (MSAP) Manipal

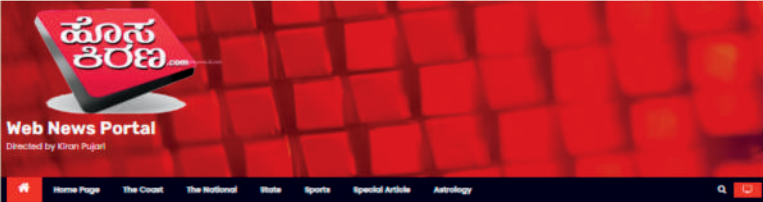
