



Number of students in the academic year 2019-2020: Total 648 students






Number & Qualification of staff in the academic year 2019-2020






Academic Results 2018-2019 Pass percentage




Scholarships for B.Sc Nursing Students

Merit cum means scholarships

- To be eligible, candidate should have secured above 90% in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in 10+2 board examination.
- Scholarship amount shall be determined based on the parents' annual income.
- > Candidates are required to pay the full first year course fee at the time of Admission.



- Candidates should also produce Notary attested photocopy of the Income Tax (IT) return form for Assessment Year 2020 -2021 for proof of parents' income before 31 August 2020.
- *The award of this scholarship for the subsequent years will be based on the performance of the candidate in the university examinations. They will have to obtain minimum aggregate 65% marks in each academic year with pass in all subjects.
